DIRECTIONS: I-85 from North or South (Newnan exit 47) to Hwy. 34 (Bullsboro Blvd.), go west .8 miles. Turn right onto Hwy. 34 By Pass (M Farmer Industrial Blvd.) & go 6 miles. Turn right onto Hwy. 34 (Franklin Road) at 4 way stop & go 8.2 miles. Turn right onto Thomas Powers Road & go 2.7 miles to 4 way stop. The road name changes to Hewlett South Road. Continue straight .9 miles. Bear left onto Bud Davis Road & go 1.9 miles. Turn right onto Flat Rock Road & continue straight to park entrance. The road name changes to Bob White Way. Continue straight to gated entrance to the park.
