This popular dining promotion features 18 participating restaurants, each of whom offers a three-course meal for just \$21.21 (plus tax/gratuity). “Great meals and a great deal; that is kind of our motto for Gwinnett Restaurant Week,” explains Lisa Anders, GCVB Marketing Communications Director. She adds, “The GCVB conceived Restaurant Week for a couple of reasons: one, to showcase some of our best restaurants to both our visitors and our locals, and by offering great value to diners.”
