Hold Your Next Event at the Historic Mansell House and Gardens

A relaxing afternoon in the early 1900s, sitting on the veranda sipping a cool drink, reminiscing with friends and family. Your eye catches a colorful bloom. Its fragrance beckons you...

Such are the delights of the Mansell House and Gardens.

The beautiful Mansell House, constructed in the Queen Anne style, was built in 1912 by Robert and Maude Mansell on what is now Mansell Road and served as the family home until 1980. It was moved to its present location in the early 1990s for restoration and adaptive reuse and is now managed and operated by the Alpharetta Historical Society.

In the years since its restoration, the Mansell House has been the setting for hundreds of special events. Preserved to reflect the essence of a bygone era, the house serves as a romantic backdrop for weddings and receptions and as a charming setting for showers, reunions and anniversary celebrations. The gardens, created and maintained by the Alpharetta Garden Club, feature a gazebo and arbor surrounded by year-round seasonal blooms, a perfect location for formal ceremonies of all types. The gardens are a First-Place Winner of the Historic Gardens Award for the State of Georgia and for the Deep South Region of the Garden Clubs of America.

The Alpharetta Historical Society provides an on-site hostess for all special events. Use of the house, garden and veranda provides space for up to 250 guests with parking available on-site or at the adjacent Wills Park. Rental fees for weddings, meetings and other events are used to fund AHS programs including maintaining the historic home, maintaining and operating the Milton Log Cabin and developing history programs for AHS members and the general public.
