The parade will be the first nighttime Christmas parade Douglasville has ever seen. Parade entry is open to residents, businesses, schools, non-profit organizations, churches, Girl and Boy Scout troops and anyone that is excited to show off their Christmas spirit. Registration for the parade is \$25 before November 25, 2010 and increases to \$50 afterwards.
